



What is USIIS?

The Utah Statewide Immunization Information System (USIIS) is a free, confidential, web-based information system that maintains immunization histories for Utah residents. USIIS consolidates immunization records from multiple providers into a central location, reducing the need to rely on parents to obtain information.

Only authorized users, such as health care providers, health insurers, schools, early childhood programs and public programs have access to USIIS. USIIS complies with all federal and state laws regarding patient privacy.

Saves time looking for immunization records

Users may view or enter immunization history

Determines which vaccines are current, due, or overdue

Prints the official Utah School Immunization Record (Pink Card)

Generates information that assists with compiling the School/Childcare Immunization Report
